Glen William Public School will once again be running the Intensive Swimming Program at Clarence Town Pool from Wednesday the 9th of October until the 23rd of October. It is expected that entry to the pool will cost \$25 per student for the ten days. There will also be a cost for bus transport which will be notified closer to the time.
