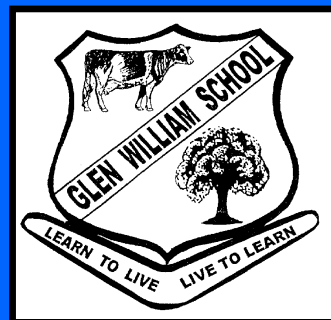

The school is now taking enrolments for 2018 Kindergarten and Years 1-6. Enrolment packs are available from the school office.

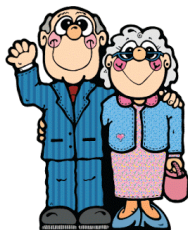
## Nude Food Friday
