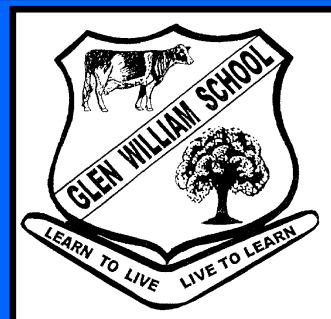

When calling the office outside of hours please leave a message and we will respond to your call as soon as possible.

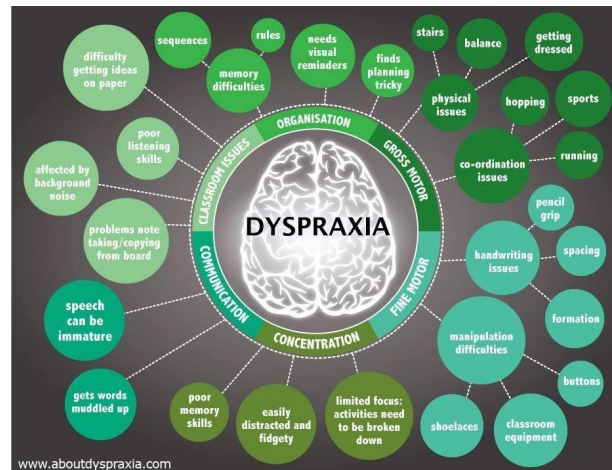
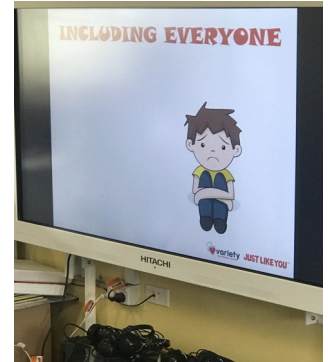
