

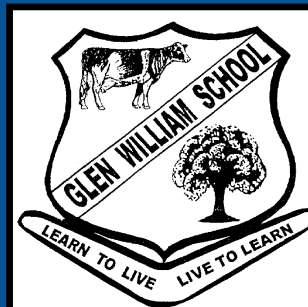

Week 10 is certainly going to be a very busy week. Please see the attached flyer to help get you organised for the last week of Term.

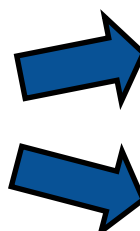
